Agile Scrum Foundation by EXIN validates technical integrated expertise in Scrum methods and Agile practices. The high volumes of transition and the resulting ambiguity will always occur at different times within the project-related culture. Those need to be efficiently handled. The course also elaborates on the similarities between the Scrum methodology and the conventional methodologies of the waterfall project, as well as the parameters of a Scrum project.

Salary Estimate:

The normal pay scale of an Agile Scrum-certified pro is **\$90,000** per annum.
